Competition Format, Rules and Judogi Rules	Mat side coaching rule will be permitted throughout the event. One coach, who must remain seated is allowed per competitor.  The wearing of white judogi is compulsory for this event; no blue judogi.  Medals will be presented as soon as the group is completed, and the necessary paperwork is available.  The decision of the Tournament Director will be final
